Broccoli-Cauliflower Salad

Submitted by Bev Seaton for your enjoyment.

1 head	Cauliflower
2 heads	Broccoli
1 can	Water Chestnuts, drained
1 bottle	Real Bacon Bits
4 ea.	Green Onions

Mayonnaise
Sugar
Vinegar

To prepare:

Clean cauliflower and broccoli, drain and cut or snap tips into little pieces.

Clean and cut green onions into small pieces.

Put cauliflower, broccoli, onions, water chestnuts and bacon bits into a bowl

In a separate bowl combine approximately 5 large tablespoons of mayonnaise enough vinegar to make the mayonnaise thinned by not runny, and add enough sugar to taste, (be generous). Raisins are optional.
