Kite Mural Up

Excerpts from article in South Beach Bulletin dated Thursday, Feb. 21, 2002.

A small but enthusiastic crowd gathered at the foot of the Public Dock in a light mist Saturday afternoon to welcome Westport's newest piece of public art. A huge kite mural, named "Higher Hopes", now adorns the side of the Bay Fishing building. The artwork features kinds of colorful kites flying high in the sky. Created on six separate sheets of 4'by8' marine plywood, it can be seen throughout the entire Manna District.

Westport Mayor Berk Barker accepted the mural on behalf of the citizens of Westport and thanked Federal Way & Westport resident Dr. Denny Frederick for his efforts to make the mural a reality.

Frederick thanked the sponsors and supporters of the project, with added words of appreciation to his family for their unwavering confidence that he would be able to put the mammoth undertaking together. Frederick then 'christened' the piece by cracking a bottle of champagne on the side of the mechanical lift amid the cheers of the crowd.

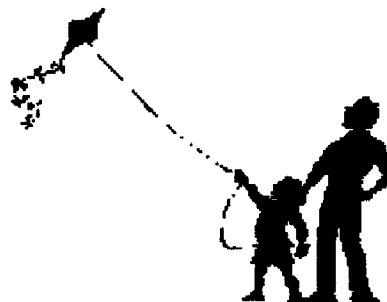

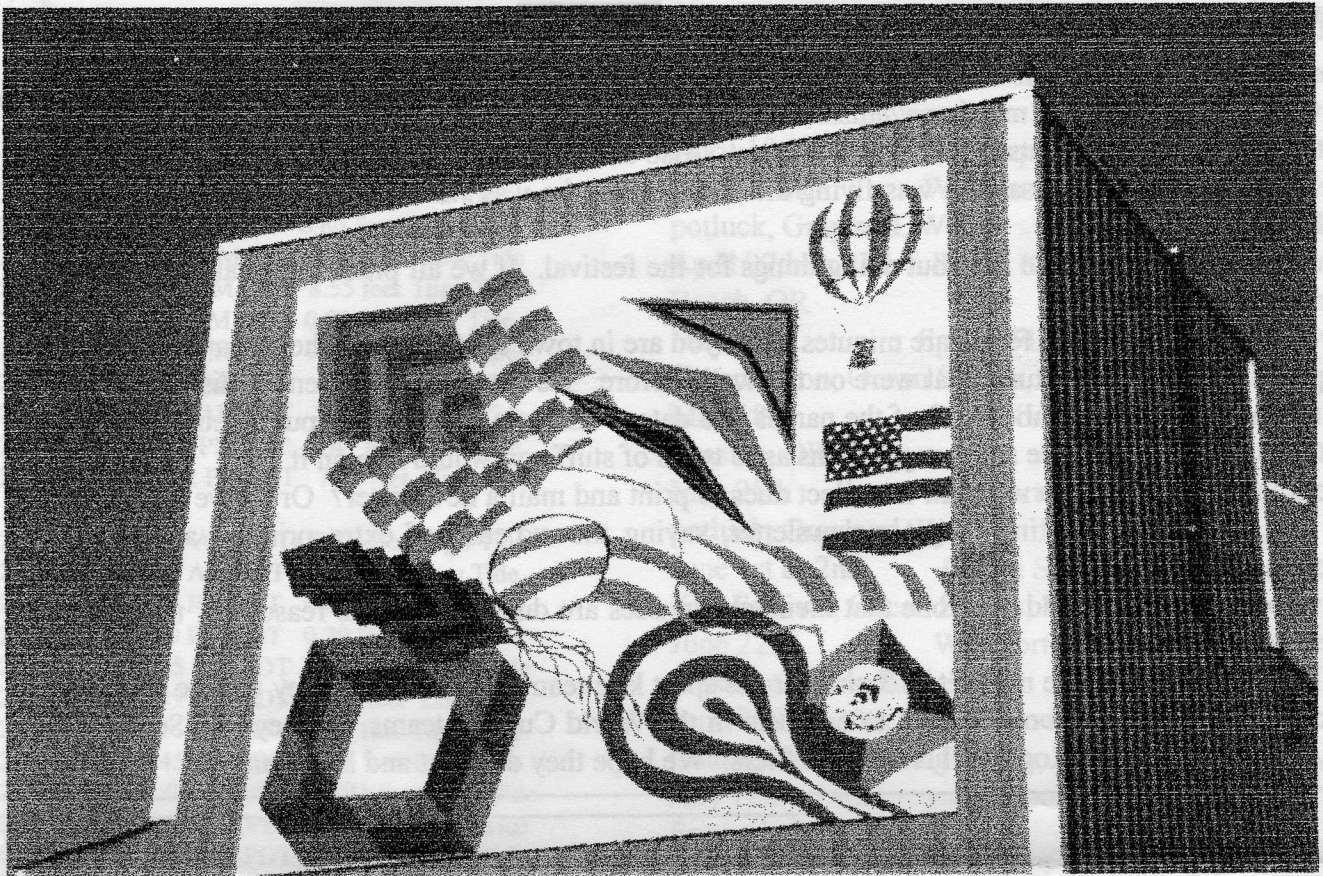

Taco Soup
